- Make your homes look occupied so thieves question whether it is safe to break in. A dog may help scare thieves as well.
- Never leave spare keys under doormats, flowerpots, mailboxes or other "secret" hiding places. If everyone does it... it isn't a secret.
- Leave lights on when you go out. Connect some lighting to automatic timers to turn on in the evening and off during the day if you plan on being away from home for extended stays.
- Install good exterior lighting with motion detectors.
- Invest in a quality home security system. Then use it.
